After working in Italy, Holland and Germany for some time Tom Wogan moved to Spain in 1993 and has remained here since. He currently works as both a *Cambridge English* consultant for Catalonia and as a teacher for the EIM (Escola d'Idiomes Moderns) at the UB, specialising in exam preparation courses. Before working for Cambridge Tom worked for a major publisher as a commercial representative and as a teacher trainer. His expertise and knowledge of both teaching and of the *Cambridge English* system is invaluable and he will be sharing his insight with us at this session.

AIMS: The aims of this seminar are:

- To introduce the update to Cambridge English: First for 2015
- To outline the changes to the exam, while highlighting continuity and teaching implications
- To provide a rationale for the revision
- To explain the development of the Speaking Assessment Scales and their relation to the CEFR
- To explore the usefulness of these scales as a tool for describing and analysing specific aspects of spoken language
- To share practical ideas for evaluating learners' speaking in the classroom
- To discuss the usefulness of online teaching tools.
